### What are Outreach Services?

Community Workers offer short-term service navigation support to older adults to help them stay safe and independent in their own home.

A Community Worker will provide service either in-person, over the telephone or online. Services are provided upon consent from the older adult. Community Workers can coordinate referrals on behalf of the older adult to improve safety, independence and quality of life.


